

Covid 19—Protocols and Contact Tracing (updated 6/2022)

In keeping with the local public schools and community practice, we will be making the following changes to the Aaron's Acres Covid-19 Protocols and Contact Tracing requirements.

Effective June 1, 2022:

Aaron's Acres will end Contact Tracing for staff, families, and participants.

If you have Covid – Guidance for Aaron's Acres Staff and participants

If you test positive for Covid, please take the following steps to protect others regardless of your Covid vaccination status:

Stay at home for at least 5 days

- Ending isolation if you had symptoms: end isolation after 5 full days if you are fever-free for 24 hours (without the use of fever-reducing medication) and your symptoms are improving.
- Ending isolation if you did NOT have symptoms: End isolation after at least 5 full days after your positive test.

Returning to work:

- After the five-day period at home, the individual must be symptom-free for 24 hours prior to returning to any Aaron's Acres programs.
 - However, if the individual remains symptomatic, he/she must remain in quarantine for up to ten (10) days.
- Masking Requirements:
 - If the individual is symptom-free and returns to Aaron's Acres programs, a mask must be worn for the next five (5) days. If the individual cannot or does not wish to wear a mask during this time, the individual should remain at home for the full ten (10) day period.
 - If the individual returns to Aaron's Acres programs and becomes symptomatic (or if he/she cannot or refuses to wear a mask), he/she will be sent home for the remainder of the full ten (10) day period.
