

Medical Assistance for Children with Disabilities

What is PH95?

Medical Assistance (also known as Medicaid) offers a range of services for physical and mental/behavioral health conditions. It covers many wraparound support services for children under 18 that are not covered, or are covered with limitations, under traditional employer plans (such as physical or speech therapies).

The PH-95 category of Medical Assistance allows children with certain health conditions or disabilities to qualify for the program without taking parental income or assets into consideration. This category of Medical Assistance can act as a secondary insurance, bridging gaps in coverage left by employer plans.

What are the eligiblity requirements for my child?

- \checkmark Under 18 years old
- \checkmark Can not have their own personal income over \$1,041 per month
- ✓ Documented health condition which affects the child's physical/neurological functioning, sensory functioning, and/or psychological functioning

What do I need to apply?



- Child's name and date of birth
- Documentation of any income in the child's name
- Paystubs or documentation of parental income
- Documentation of medical condition or disability
