


To officially become a Fundraising Champion for Aaron's Acres during the ExtraGive event, please follow these steps:


1. Visit the <u>Aaron's Acres ExtraGive page</u> and click on the "Fundraise" button at the top of the page. You will enter your information and then you will receive a confirmation email with more details, including the link to your personalized fundraising page.



If you scroll to the bottom of the Aaron's Acres ExtraGive page you will see a list of fundraisers for our organization and you can click to their stories to see examples of how to personalize your own fundraising page.




2. To make changes to your personal page, you can visit the GiveGab site: https://www.givegab.com/users/sign_in *GiveGab is the platform that services the ExtraGive.






3. Within your Give Gab account, you'll be able to set up your personalized page using the dashboard. Click on the headings to add a supporting photo and tell your own story - why are you choosing to support Aaron's Acres? You can also set a personal fundraising goal if you'd like to.



Your profile photo can be set up/changed under Personal Settings, which is found in the dropdown menu in the top right-hand side of your screen (click on the arrow next to your name/photo).



Then - spread the word! You can share via email and/or on social media directly from your dashboard. There's also a personal link that you can copy and paste as needed, if you prefer. People won't be able to donate until the ExtraGive kicks off on November 22nd.
