Prior to coming to us in this position Madison was an Area Supervisor at Keystone Human Services, working with adults with disabilities. She has a Bachelor's Degree in Rehabilitation and Human Services and a Master's Degree in Special Education. Madison began with us over 8 years ago as a Counselor, working with our camp program. Her ability to connect with the campers, regardless of their abilities and challenges, was noteworthy right from the start. She continued to work with us adding sessions of camp and then began working with our monthly school year program over the years. As she gained more experience in working with people of all abilities and disabilities, she became a Group Leader and then a Site Supervisor. In all of her interactions with the participants, she has always demonstrated compassion, patience and understanding. Her ability to encourage each participant to do his/her best while knowing when to support them has always been a strength of hers. Madison's commitment to our organization and

her willingness to help us in whatever way was needed was consistently evident.

As our Administrative Team realized that we wanted to expand all of our existing programs and introduce programs to older participants, we knew that Madison was the perfect candidate to make this happen.
